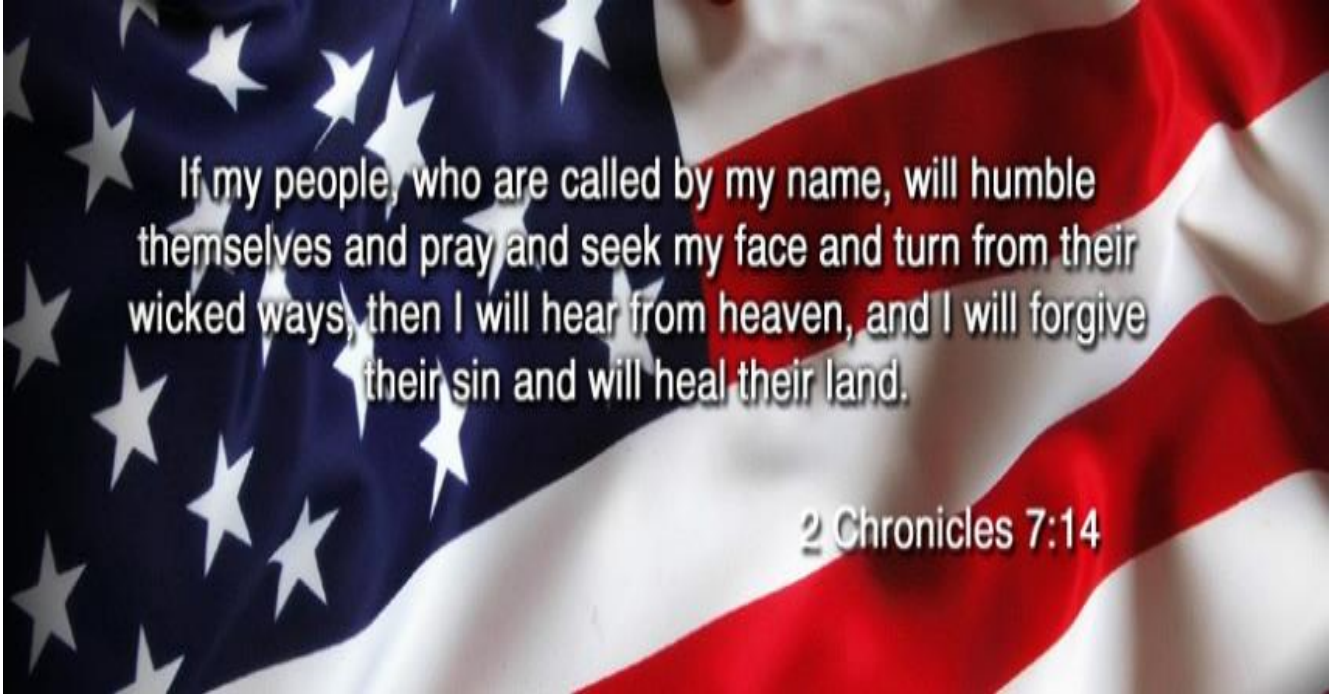

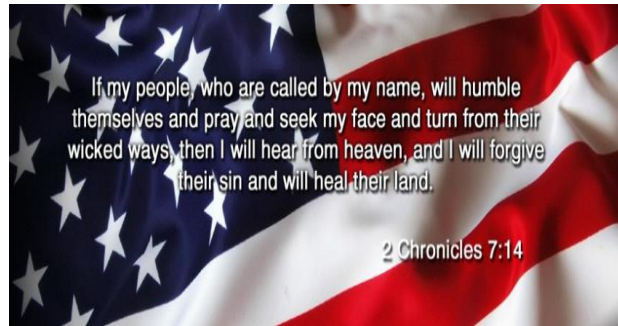

An Appeal To Heaven is humbling ourselves during the month of September through praying, fasting and appealing to God for His forgiveness and healing for our nation, while asking for wisdom in applying His Word to our lives for the rest of 2020 and beyond.

2 Chronicles 7:14 NKJV

*if My people who are called by My name will **humble themselves**, and **pray** and **seek My face**, and **turn from their wicked ways**, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.*

Appeal To Heaven

will help you ask the LORD for His mercy and divine intervention to forgive and heal our nation.

The LORD wants to continue to bless our nation but will not tolerate any unrepented sin of a rebellious people.

In order to make a humble appeal to the LORD for healing for our nation, we must draw close to Him and ask for forgiveness and mercy.

We have learned that worship, along with prayer and fasting and reading the Bible is the best way to draw close and ask the LORD for help, healing and to hear His voice.

We will set aside the month of September to pray for our nation and ask the LORD for boldness in fulfilling our responsibility as a people called by HIS Name.

We will use this Prayer Journal to remind us to humble ourselves, repent, pray, and take an active role in how the LORD wants us to represent Him as HIS people...the Church.

Sunday Worship and Wednesdays Nights are dedicated to corporate worship, the WORD and prayer. Our meals for September are impacted by a fast that each individual will have to choose to make a way to humble the soul as we make an appeal to God.

Developing Your Own Plan

to *humbling yourself* and pleading for the Lord's compassion, forgiveness and healing for our nation.

An Appeal To Heaven each day

1. Worship

We will follow the instructions from the Word of God in...

Psalms 100:4 NASU

Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise.

a. Thanksgiving

Each day a specific scripture is provided in your journal dealing with Thanking God to encourage you to reflect on God's past blessings and give thanks.

b. Praise

A specific scripture is given dealing with Praising God. This is to encourage you to think about God's greatness and to honor Him by expressing your appreciation of who He is.

2. Reading the Bible

Reading the Word of God builds our faith to receive the answers to prayer.

Many of us will also follow the reading plan in the One Year Bible. Others will use a different plan.

3. Prayer

Each day you will place before God...

1. Our three main ***Appeals To Heaven*** for:

A. All those who need God.

B. Be the Church and walk in the authority of our Lord Jesus.

C. Compassion, forgiveness, and healing for our nation.

2. Ask God for opportunities to "*Make A Difference*"

a) A request that He reveals His will for you...

b) A "Daily Corporate Prayer Request" and...

c) Requests from your own Personal Prayer List.

You can begin now to list your prayer requests on the pages that are labeled Personal Prayer List.

4. Journaling

There is also a place (My Prayer Journal) for you to write your...

1. Own thoughts on that day.
2. Requests, prayers and petitions you are making.
3. Guidance and impressions that God provides.
4. Answers you receive to your prayers.

Continuing Reflection

Finally, the last few pages of the Journal (October Reflecting) are for you to reflect on these past 30 days.

1. What Did I Hear From God and What Will I Do About It?

As you continue to listen to God you can write down your impressions that came during the 30 days. Record the important things you should do because of what you have heard from the LORD.

2. My Prayer List for 2020 A.D. and beyond. This may be the last time and best way to keep our nation strong, healthy and submitted to God before the end of the year and into the next 4 years and beyond.

Your Personal Appeal To Heaven Plan

How will I make Worship a part of each day?

Your Journal includes scriptures of thanksgiving and praise which you can **read aloud**.

Many of us will **listen** to Christian music and possibly **sing along** in worship at various times during the day.

We will assemble on Sundays and Wednesday Nights to enjoy lifting our voices together in worship.

How will I keep a regular schedule of Reading God's Word?

There are several Bible verses listed in the **Journal** for each day. The verses are to help remind us who we are and humble ourselves before God by thanking and praising Him for who He is. It will be of great value to read out loud and meditate on those scriptures. In addition, you are encouraged to have a regular plan of reading / listening to the Word.

For example:

- a) Read the One Year Bible,
- b) Read the New Testament portion of the One Year Bible,
- c) Read just the Psalms and Proverbs readings in the One Year Bible,
- d) Read a chapter from a book of the Bible daily or
- e) Any other plan of your choosing.

How will I set aside my time for Personal Prayer?

For example:

- a) Pray first thing in the morning (5 minutes, 1 hour, etc.),
- b) Attend prayer meetings on Wednesday Nights, Sunday Worship at the church and at Life Groups.
- c) Pray during a meal that I skip, etc.

How will I carry out my Personal Fasting?

(Fasting is abstaining from food or abstaining from a certain kind of food.)

For example:

- a) Do the Daniel fast, do a modified Daniel fast like no meat, or no caffeine, no sweets, etc.,
- b) Do a no carb, no sugar, no caffeine...fast.
- c) Skip one meal per day.
- d) Skip two meals per day.
- e) Don't eat out or eat fast food.
- f) Some combination of methods of fasting.

The important thing is to have a plan and stick with it.

The LORD'S Prayer Pattern

Many Christians recite the Lord's Prayer word for word almost without much thought or passion, but there's so much more to this prayer. The Lord Jesus provided this model as an outline to teach us how to pray in a way that connects us to God the Father, aligns our priorities with His, and helps us live dependently on Him and follow Him through obedience and example. This model takes us through each part of The Lord's Prayer, showing us how to pray the way the Lord Jesus instructed.

Matthew 6:9-13 NKJV

9 **In this manner, therefore, pray:**

Our Father in heaven,

CONNECT WITH GOD RELATIONALLY:

God doesn't want religion...He desires a relationship with us.

God has adopted us as His children and loves for us to call Him our Father.

Let's start our prayer time acknowledging our relationship with God as our Father in heaven.

Proclaim your intimate relationship with God every day by addressing Him lovingly as your Father and thanking Him that you are His child.

Hallowed be Your name.

WORSHIP HIS NAME:

God loves when we worship Him and there is power in His Name.

Here is a list of some of His Names to help us worship Him specifically and personally:

Jehovah – Tsidkenu: The LORD is our Righteousness! “He forgives all our iniquities”

**God is our righteousness who placed our iniquities in Christ.*

Jehovah – Rapha: The LORD is our Healer! “He heals all of our diseases”

**God is our physician who places our diseases on Christ.*

Jehovah – Nissi: The LORD is our Victory! “He redeems our life from destruction”

**God is our Protector who defeated all the forces of darkness in Christ.*

Jehovah – Shammah: The LORD is our Presence! “He crowns us with lovingkindness”

**God is our Presence who sent us the Holy Spirit in Christ.*

Jehovah – Jireh: The LORD is our Provider! “He satisfies us with good things”

**God is our Provider who supplied all our needs in Christ.*

Jehovah – Rohi: The LORD is our Shepherd! “He tends and cares for us”

**God cares for us and leads us to still waters and green pastures.*

Speak God's Names out loud.

When we proclaim who He is, we worship Him and reminds ourselves how powerful and great our God is. Speaking out loud the Names of God also makes the enemy tremble with fear.

10 Your kingdom come. Your will be done On earth as it is in heaven.

MAKE HIS KINGDOM AND RIGHTEOUSNESS THE PRIORITY:

His Kingdom is the fruit of the Spirit.

God's divine character in control of our thoughts, words, and actions.

God's will is perfect, and we acknowledge His wisdom and sovereignty when we pray His agenda first.

God will always give us all we need from day to day if we will make His Kingdom our priority.

*God's priorities include: *Saving the lost *Wisdom and guidance for those in authority— parental, spiritual, governmental, work-related * Caring for the poor, marginalized and unborn * Unity and love *Justice *Freedom for those in bondage *Accomplishing His purpose in our lives.*

11 Give us this day our daily bread.

DEPEND ON HIM FOR EVERYTHING:

God wants us to let our needs be known to Him.

God promises to supply all our needs.

God wants us to come to Him with our problems, needs, and desires and to trust Him to provide.

12 And forgive us our debts, As we forgive our debtors.

FORGIVE AND BE FORGIVEN:

God has offered us complete forgiveness whenever we confess and ask...through Christ Jesus.

The LORD is faithful and just to forgive us every time we confess our sins to HIM.

We are strengthened to forgive others when we turn away from our sins and receive His forgiveness.

God wants us to pray for others, including those who challenge healthy relationships and even enemies.

God wants us to "stand in the gap" before HIM for mercy of our families, friends, city, state, and nation.

13 And do not lead us into temptation, But deliver us from the evil one.

ENGAGE IN SPIRITUAL WARFARE:

God wants us to fight against the powers of darkness.

The Lord said that our enemy came to steal, kill and destroy us, but JESUS came to give us abundant life.

God wants you to take authority in resisting demonic attack in your health, finances, family, ministry & nation.

God empowers us with the Holy Spirit to pray, stand firm in the faith and fight against the enemy.

God has already given us the victory through Jesus.

There is power in God's Word, and with HIS Truth we can defeat every lie the enemy has told us.

Through prayer, we can resist the enemy and continue to walk forward in freedom.

Our prayers along with the BLOOD of JESUS...the WORD of GOD...our Testimony proclaims our victory!

For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.

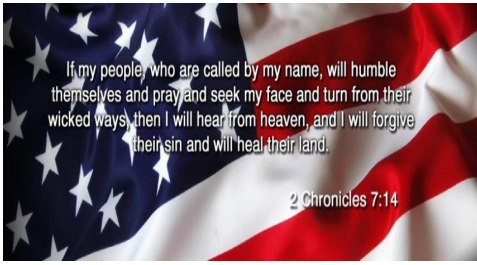
PROCLAIM GOD IS ALMIGHTY FOREVERMORE:
